Claim Filed Against Ruby

The federal government has filed a claim of \$45,637 for back taxes against the estate of Jack Ruby, the man who killed Lee Harvey Oswald, an Internal Revenue Service source confirmed Thursday.

The IRS said the claim became a matter of public record Tuesday and is for taxes dating back to 1956 over five separate

tax periods.

Ruby died of cancer in Jan-

uary.

Oswald was named by the Warren Commission as the assassin of President Kennedy.
