Doctor Says Ruby Planned Suicide

DALLAS, Aug. 13 (UPI) — The doctor who treated the late Jack Ruby in jail said today it wasn't really Lee Harvey Oswald that Ruby meant to kill—it was Ruby himself.

Dr. John W. Callahan, who was a parttime jail doctor when Ruby was in jail in Dallas awaiting a second trial, said Ruby had strong suicide tendencies.

"He was rather reluctant to accept this. He was secretive and was hiding his true feelings," Callahan said. "He seemed to be a very neurotic and nervous person. He was suicidal. He was depressed and had quite a time of being very glum and blue."
