I think it is unusually odd that Henry Hurt relied so much on your information and research material, yet you must have never suggested to him that he talk to me about my knowledge of Oswald in New Orleans. Here I am, in Hattiesburg, just as available as Mr. Easterling (and willing to talk for for a price that is considerably less than what Easterling charged), yet Hurt asked me no questions about Oswald.

You know and I know that some of the people in the Pizzo Exhibit #453-A (photo of Oswald at Trade Mart) have been identified, and you know that I took the picture. You also know that the FBI and Secret Service tried to identify the "unidentified" young men in the photo. Yet Hurt published the photo in his book and said in the caption: "There has been no known official effort to make an identification."

Even though his statement, "Though Mr. Weisberg often expressed sharp disagreement with my approach to certain aspects of the case..." seems to get you off the hook, he could not have put your name in the "Acknowledgments" without your approval.

I find it extremely amusing that Hurt says that right after the assassination Easterling drove to within 20 miles of your farm and "cracked a safe" in Hagerstown. Surely, Harold, you weren't involved in the assassination plot with Easterling, were you?
