

Russell Statement

LONDON—Lord Bertrand Russell declared that his former secretary, Ralph Schoenman, had been removed from all participation in the Bertrand Russell Peace Foundation.

Russell said in a statement: "I have tried to obtain from Mr. Ralph Schoenman of New York an undertaking that he will not use my name in any way whatsoever to suggest that I am associated with his activities or he with mine. My request has been ignored."

A pioneer of Britain's ban-the-bomb movement in the early 1960s, Schoenman was a founder-director of the Russell Peace Foundation when it was established in 1963.
