
torcycycle which was stolen in Jefferson Parish.
Alcock said he charged Moore with possession of the motorcycle, which was the property of Charles Elrod, 1615 Brockenbrough Ct.
Several other articles, including two radios, a tape recorder and a ring were also seized.
However, police have been unable to prove that they were stolen, Alcock said. One victim in the Fontcuberta burglary at first identified the ring as similar to one that was stolen, but later, after being informed of certain inscriptions on the ring, said it could not be the same.
Alcock said the safe deposit box key was valued at $\$ 1$ after he learned from a bank official that this is what is costs to duplicate such keys.

State law says that when the value of the stolen things possessed amounts to less than $\$ 20$, the offender can be fined not more than $\$ 500$ or imprisoned for not more than six months. He may also be fined and jailed for up to the maximum amounts.

The maximum penalty for possessiong stolen property is up to 10 years when the value of the stolen property exceeds $\$ 100$.
