* [REDACTED] KANSAS CITY, KS., ADVISED THIS DATE THAT HE BELIEVED SUBJECT IN FIFTYNINE DATED A WOMAN KNOWN ONLY AS RUSTY, WHO RAN THE M AND M TAVERN IN AN ALLEY BETWEEN FRANKLIN AND GLENDALE STREETS IN PEORIA, ILL. [REDACTED] COULD FURNISH NO OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION REGARDING RUSTY OTHER THAN SHE HAD RED HAIR. STATED FRIEND [REDACTED] PEORIA, WOULD KNOW HER COMPLETE IDENTITY. [REDACTED] SAW INDIVIDUAL BELIEVED TO BE IDENTICAL TO SUBJECT IN PEACOCK TAVERN, THIRTYFIRST AND TROOST, KANSAS CITY, MO., APPROXIMATELY ONE YEAR AGO. THIS MAN IN TAVERN DENIED KNOWING [REDACTED] AT FIRST HOWEVER, AFTER A FEW DRINKS HE ADMITTED KNOWING 'RUSTY' AND PRODUCED A LOCK OF HER HAIR HE WAS CARRYING IN HIS WALLET. [REDACTED] REMEMBERS MAN BEING CALLED RAY AND STATES HE GENERALLY ANSWERS DESCRIPTION OF SUBJECT.
