Dear Mr. Streit,

Your letter of 2/4 has been forwarded by Dell. I thank you for the kind things you say. These, to date, are our only reward.

May I suggest that what you say reflects an attitude as important to the genuine defense of our country as anything you may do in the armed forces? It is comforting to know that men with immediate and serious problems are deeply concerned about this issue and want to know what to do.

I wish I could give you a better answer to that question. The essential thing for concerned citizens in a society such as ours you are doing. That is to inform yourselves, and in the way you are, by examining all sides. Next, I believe it is important to make your voices heard as best you can, in letters to your legislators and the White House. One man is a very small percentage of 200,000,000, but if enough individuals express themselves, the total will be noted and perhaps heeded. Whether or not it is heeded, it is the responsibility of all of us.

I have published two more books since WHITEWASH II (just enclosed). If OSWALD IN NEW ORLEANS is available to you through normal channels, it is but 95 cents. We have to add a handling and postage charge. There is no other version of the third book, which is perhaps the most shocking and is the most suppressed. It is available almost nowhere.

You might want to read the Playboy Garrison interview.
