I was so sickened by this article that I could barely plow through it. I cannot believe how naive--in the least--the guy is, how he fails to understand anything about the workings of government, and how dishonest & unscholarly he is.

There is really littel for me to say. What can anybody say about such drivell as his explanation for why the government has released info proving conspiracy? Or his explanation of the Kennedy's silence? Or how he eliminates Hoover and the right from consideration as conspirators? The Bundy thesis is ridiculous and totally unsupported.
