what Anna Sandhu, a 32-year-old free-lance artist, told the Knoxville Journal in an interview on her plans to marry James Earl Ray, convicted slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Sandhu says Ray is "a lovable man, and not an anti-social maniac." At Brushy Mountain Penitentiary, Warden Stonney Lane said, "I don't know a thing about it. James hasn't made any

kind of formal request. . . . He'd be right back in his cell after it's over," said the warden. "I don't play Cupid for these people."
