ON MARCH TWENTYONE LT. E. H. ARKIN, INSPECTIONAL BUREAU, WY PROCERE MEMPHIS, TENN., PD, ADVISED THAT A MASS MARCH IN SUPPORT OF CURRENT STRIKE SCHEDULED TO BEGIN NINE AM, CST, MARCH TWENTYTWO NEXT. MARCHERS TO MARCH ON BLOCKED OFF STREETS IN DOWNTOWN MEMPHIS. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., PRESIDENT OF SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP (SCLC), TO LEAD MARCH.

ON MACH IWENTYONE SOURCE ONE CONFIRMED THIS INFORMATION POINTING OUT THAT CONCERTED CAMPAIGN BEING CONDUCTED BY NAACP, MEMPHIS NEGRO CHURCHES, NEGRO CIVIC CLUBS, NEGRO BUSINESS AND NEGRO LABOR UNION LEADERS TO HAVE THOUSANDS OF ADULT AND SCHOOL AGE NEGROES MARCH ON MARCH IMENTYTWO. SOURCE ONE PREDICTS AT LEAST TEN THOUSAND MARCHERS IF WEATHER IS FAIR. ADDING THAT JAMES BEVEL, OF SCLC STAFF, HAS REMAINED IN MEMPHIS ALL WEEK TO ORGANIZE THE MARCH AND IS VISITING COLLEGES IN MEMPHIS MAKING MILITANT BLACK POWER SPEECHES TO STIMULATE 157-9146-103 MARCH SUPPORT .
