Missing DA Witness Is Back on Job

A Cuban who had been questioned in connection with Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's assassination probe and who was earlier reported missing showed up for work in Miami today.

Emile Santana, 31, who is on probation for a suspended three-year attempted larceny sentence, was reported missing by his probation officer, Russell W. Buckholt Jr. of the Florida Parole and Probation Commission.

Santana was flown to New Orleans and questioned by Garrison's staff Feb. 14 until Feb. 17. According to Buckholt, he had been missing from his home in Miami since Friday.

Later today, a spokesman for the company which employs Santana, Standard Auto Bumper Corp. said that Santana came to work today.
