May I express my appreciation for what today must be described as your courage in printing the three very worthwhile articles by Leo Sauvage: I believe I am an expert in this field, and I intend no reflection on M. Sauvage in claiming to be even more of an expert than he, so I am in a position to evaluate his articles. Almost unique among the limited writings about the Warren Commission, his pieces have been devoid of factual error, a failing that has characterized almost everything I have seen.
