

Schlesinger Divorced

Marian C. Schlesinger, wife of historian Arthur M. Schlesinger Jr., was granted a divorce Monday in Middlesex, Mass. Probate Court.

She charged her husband of more than 30 years with "cruel and abusive treatment" and was awarded \$4,700 per month in alimony. The couple has three children.

Schlesinger, who lives in New York, was an aide to President John F. Kennedy and won two Pulitzer prizes. He is a former professor at Harvard University and authored the book, "A Thousand Days: John F. Kennedy in the White House."
