I hope your personal situation has improved. And that it can give you a bit of mobility. If it does, and if I can't get out there, which now seems likely, unless I can get a paid speaking engagement, there may be two things I will want to ask of you, one in Portland and one, if you can get there, in Seattle. Both will be delicate and each would probably have a better chance of success if you have an establishmentarian appearance, which you may find uncongenial.
