Dear Gary Schoener,

I recall our conversation. Glad you are working on the autopsy. I've had my book on it finished for about 4 months. I then had to add a postscript and as soon as I have a chance I'll be going over that. I would like to see what you have and, if you agree, possibly use parts of it with credit. I also project an appendix of about 200 pages.

If you have any apprehensions, use registered mail. I see no alternative to using both the mails and phone and do so with as little inhibition as possible.

Your belief about ordering books from the stores is soundly based, if the author has a publisher. I do not know what you have. It is possible you have the all editions of my earlier books. I am not familiar with the pagination in them. Therefore, I am sending you under separate cover a set of all four. Your check is adequate. If we have communication from receipt on, I'll know the material you may be interested in and can give you citations. At least, I still remember a good deal of it. I have to confess there is so much and I am so tired I have forgotten much of what I have published.

I would welcome a trip to your area. I know snow and ice. Our land has been covered with it since Christmas. This morning, in feeding the birds, I went in over the tops of my boots. However, with no resources and no publisher paying my expenses, I can go only where my expenses are paid. This usually means a TV station that wants me or a college that wants a speech, as last year, in your general area, in Madison and later, Milwaukee.

Thanks for your kind comments. And we'll add you to our mailing list, so you'll know when our next book is ready. We have a separate list of those who want automatic shipment of each book, if you'd prefer that.
