Dear Gary,

Adding to what I also wrote Paul, Bud agrees with me that what you should have received by now is possibly the most important single thing to date. He may be thinking as a lawyer. We were too-often interrupted by the needs of his clientele. We'll also be with others Thursday and probably will not have much time for further discussion. He'll come up here Saturday, I expect, for what I can only hope will be the final decision on what we'll sue for.

Paul has not yet responded to my question, will he promise to keep this entirely to himself if I send it to him. I have a copy of everything put aside for the moment I get his affirmative answer. Until then I am not even writing him about the contents.

If you have a contrary evaluation or any suggestions, please send them when you have time. As you realize from the follow-up letters, I am not letting it drop there. Also, no further responses.

With the Xerox 7000, Paul can make copies of the add. for about \$4.50 if the original Xerox I'll send is black enough. When I have even that small sum for a number of copies, I'll make some. This could also provide means of getting additional copies of the others.

Enclosed is a copy of the corrections Paul suggests, not inclusive, for if it would be possible to make more elaborate changes, he gave me to understand he'd have had recommendations. This is to save you time in noting them where they duplicate.
