In terms of that unusual note Harold got, my professional skills do not tell me anymore than anyone else's judgment-- even if it is a put on, the guy may be a nut (you have to generally be nutty to act nutty once the act gets beyond a certain point). I doubt that it is a threat or that the guy is dangerous, but it is hard to understand such things in any reasonable terms.

I have no idea who that guy is in the Penn Jones piece. I have never seen the picture before. The guy is not necessarily under arrest. I doubt that it is the long-gone Jack Beers photo of which I wrote in 1967 which was destroyed but allegedly showed a guy being brought out of the TSB under arrest.

The Russian piece sounds interesting. I will try to get a copy.

What I am up to lately is gone through in my letter to Harold which is enclosed.
