The classic work in this area was done by Eric Norden (Realist, no. 73, p. 1, 4-22, Feb. 1967). A series of short articles on the subject were put out in one paperbound pamphlet entitled "The Assassination of Malcolm X: 1. Unanswered Questions by George Breitenman, 2. The Trial by Herman Porter." It is available from Merit Publishers, 873 Broadway, New York, N.Y. 10003 for 50¢. These are reprinted from the Militant.

If I can be of further help to you on this subject please get in touch. I have tried to involve some blacks in looking into the case but with little success. While the parallels to other assassinations I draw in my memo are meant to be ironic, I do feel that it is possible that there was at least high level foreknowledge of the murder of Malcolm X. While not a Malcolm X fan, I do feel that the possibilities of higher level involvement are disturbing.
