

Schoolfield Wins Session Judge Seat

CHATTANOOGA (AP) — Raulston Schoolfield, who was disbarred from legal practice in Tennessee following an impeachment in 1958 from a Criminal Court judgeship, won a seat as General Sessions judge in Thursday's elections.

Schoolfield has made several political races since his impeachment, including winning election to the Hamilton County Council.

He has also waged an unsuccessful battle to regain his right to practice law.

A sessions judge does not have to have a license to practice law.
