Dear Harold:

I thought I would write to you from here in Portugal (one of the Best Dictatorships on the Iberian Peninsula) and advise you that I still think you are correct in your analysis of the Kennedy-thing.

Also, I suppose as you indicated to me in one of your letters that I have no courage; that, you are correct, there, also.

But, the thing which I do not understand is: there can be no question but that Oswald could not have done the killing alone. He had co-assassins; or, he was a fall-

Guy, and I cannot criticize the
efforts of Jim Garrison (as Garrison)
— that took a great deal of fortitude,
and guts, and a calculated knowledge
that no conviction on the Shaw-
trial meant certain re-
crimination.

It is almost as though a
review of the Lincoln Assassination
was being treated by historians; let
me tell you, Harold, you have per-
formed with a courage I lack; and
that history will show you to be
accurate, or at least, precise.

I don't think the whole thing is
over, yet. I think truth will
come (despite as Mark Lane says; the
abysmal ignorance — is obvious) and,
guys like you, Harold, are O.K.;
and I'll be back in N.Y. June 1st
