## No Conspiracy on JFK, FBI Chief Says

BOSTON - FBI Director Clarence Kelley says there was no conspiracy involved in the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, according to the Boston Sunday Herald Advertiser.

"I think it's solved now. And I don't know of any connection with any conspiracy," Kelley said in an interview with the Hearst Newspapers. "We're not discarding that as a possibility. We will explore it.

"But we feel we have determined who assassinated the President and we feel that this will be borne out by the review of our investigation."
