

Senator Says Agencies Lied to Warren Panel

WASHINGTON, May 14 (AP)—The Central Intelligence Agency and Federal Bureau of Investigation lied to the Warren Commission about the assassination of President Kennedy, a Senate Intelligence Committee member said today. The Senator also suggested that "we pursue some hot leads" to answer for certain who killed Mr. Kennedy.

Senator Richard Schweiker, Pennsylvania Republican and a member of the panel's subcommittee investigating the assassination, said "there is no question in my mind" that the two intelligence agencies lied to the commission that conducted the Government's first, massive inquiry into Mr. Kennedy's death.

Mr. Schweiker said he has found no new evidence about who killed Kennedy but declared, "If we pursue some hot leads, we may well answer that question." Mr. Schweiker refused to elaborate on what he meant by "hot leads."
