RONALD A. SCHWINGEAULIER, Route 1, Albany, Minnesota, made available the following information:

SCHWINGMARMER stated that in 1960 he had been assigned to the United States Harine Air Control Equadron #1, Atsugi, Japan. Shortly before he arrived at Atsugi, Japan, LEE OSWALD, who had been assigned to the same squadron, had been sent here. OSWALD had a reputation for being an odd ball, a radical, and there was a lot of talk about him even alter he left the squadron. He was not personally acquainted with OSWALD, but one RICK THORMMEY, who was gathering material for a beek, eventually published under "The Idle Warrigr," was acquainted with OSWALD, since THORMMEY had also lived in New Orleans, Louisiana.

SCHWINGHAMMER advised that if the book written by THORELEY had to do with the personnel of the Marine Air Control Squadron #1, it may possibly have some reference to OSWALD.
