It was on the corner of Lafayette and Magazine and extended from the corner to Alba's. I first noticed it my first trip to N.O. On the morning of my departure Fenner Sedgebeer was driving me to various places. I was, obviously, fascinated by that area and the proximities, so I noted much. I believe the name was pretty close to the one in this memo where Layton Martens is said to have claimed to have been working the day of the assassination.
