Dear Mr. Weisburg,

While I was in Washington in February, I got a chance to look at the material that was released from 1965 on, despite my age. Even though the Archives did not show me everything released during that time span, I obtained several interesting photostatic copies of some of these documents.

On one of them, I failed to get the first page of a two page report by "Edward F. Bray EC."

The top of the second page, which I obtained, this is what appears:

"The organization... JFCOT\*"

The assassin... a distinguished ex-serviceman

The weapon... a high-powered rifle

The method... a sniper's bullet as you ride in an open car.

The location... a parade in Dallas, Texas.

It (the report) also states that the above was sent "in a letter mailed August 12, 1963, to a member of the President's Cabinet," and then "after the Dallas tragedy these details, along with photostats & photo's were sent to the Warren Commission."

There is another document with this at the top:


Memorandum for: Mr. J. Lee Rankin
