He also was at the Trade Mart. But here we may have the incident of the FBI man. He is described as a white male, 45 years, 6' 2", 185 to 190 pounds, grey hair, and unidentified. He allegedly was following the nurse, Mrs. Nelson, into the emergency room at about 1:30. When asked his identity, "he shouted that he was an FBI. Just as we began to ask for his credentials he ^{abruptly} ~~abruptly~~ attempted to enter the emergency room and had to be forcibly restrained by us. ASAIC Kellerman then appeared and asked this individual to go to the end of the hall." Cong. Teague of Texas witnessed the incident and he and the nurse both offered statements if needed.
