On December 1 he also made a special statement concerning advance arrangements which appears on pp.789-90.

He saw none of the events but stayed in Dallas working with Agent Sorrels and the police. Inspector Kelley also was there. Grant left Dallas about midnight of the 23rd, "carrying a blow^{rr}up of the photograph showing Oswald holding a rifle similar to the one used in the assassination which I was to deliver to our agents at the White House."
