He was with the vice Presidential followup car and places the time of the first shot at about 12:35 p.m. He said he heard two shots approximately "2 or 3 seconds apart, ... ". He ^{had} started running towards the Vice President's car when he heard a third shot. He was left on the street when the motorcade picked up speed. He was picked up by "White House moviemen" and arrived at the hospital 12:45-12:50. The balance of the report is dev_oted to the security measures taken for the new President.
