

Statements of Witnesses - Secret Service Agent JERRY D. KYVETT<sup>I</sup>

He was in the Vice Presidential detail in the followup car. He could not see the Presidential car well during the entire parade route. There is nothing in this statement dealing with the assassination.

However, he has more than 3 pages in a separate statement, also dated November 29, pp.778-81. He saw nothing, describes hearing the explosions, the <sup>second</sup> ~~XXXX~~ and 1/3rd of which he was sure were shots, the radio communications between the various agents, and says the trip to the hospital took about 4 minutes. The rest of the report deals with security arrangements for the new President and his family, the travel and their arrangements.
