Dear Mr. Roffman:

Reference is made to your letter dated June 17, 1977, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act.

Enclosed are copies of Secret Service documents which pertain to your request. These documents have had information deleted from them because they contain investigatory information compiled for law enforcement purposes. Pursuant to Title 5, United States Code, Section 552(b)(7)(C), and (F), they are being exempted since disclosure would constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy to other persons mentioned in the requested file, and endanger the life or physical safety of law enforcement personnel. Some deletions are being made pursuant to Title 5, United States Code, Section 552(b)(5) as matters that are inter-agency or intra-agency memoranda, and others in accordance with Title 5, United States Code, Section 552(b)(2) as information that pertains solely to the internal rules and practices of the agency. The citations of the above exemptions are not to be construed as the only exemptions which may be available under the Freedom of Information Act. The other documents you requested were originated by other government agencies and have been referred to those agencies for their direct response to you.

Specifically, in your paragraph #1, you requested "your November 4th memorandum to the Secretary." This document originated with the Department of the Treasury and has been referred to that Department for a determination as to its release.




In your paragraph #2, you requested "a letter dated November 28, 1966, from Martin Richman." This document originated with the Department of Justice and has been referred to that Department for a determination as to its release. You also requested a copy of "an attached receipt." This document was originated by the National Archives and has been referred to that agency for a determination as to its release.

Fees are charged in accordance with Title 31 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1A, Section 1.6(g). For the requested documents, retrieval time was one hour at \$5.00 per hour and 3 xerox pages at \$.10 per page. Please send a certified check or money order in the amount of \$5.30 payable to U. S. Secret Service, Financial Management Division, 1800 G Street, N.W., Room 905, Washington, D.C. 20223.

If you disagree with our determination, you have the right of administrative appeal within 35 days by writing to Freedom of Information Appeal, Deputy Director, U.S. Secret Service, 1800 G Street, N.W., Room 944, Washington, D.C. 20223.
