
Dear Sir:

The Secret Service is unable to furnish you with the information requested in your letter of August 19, 1972. We do not have such information and any documents we had have been transferred to the Archives.

As you know in a letter dated December 8, 1970, the Office of Administration of the General Services Administration denied your appeal concerning the "memorandum of transfer" of the materials relating to the autopsy of President Kennedy. This "memorandum of transfer" is not in the possession of the United States Secret Service, but if it was, access to it would be denied on the same basis as it was denied by the General Services Administration.

Further request for information concerning the assassination of President Kennedy should be, as indicated heretofore, addressed to the Archivist of the United States.
