Dear Mr. Hinkley,

Thank you very much for the additional information in your 6/27 and your continuing efforts to be informative about a matter made confusing by the malfunctioning of other agencies in this matter that was not addressed by them until three years after the time limit of the Act.

If I correctly understood your effort not to criticize others, DJ Criminal made the wrong referral three years late. OK.

This requires no response. My purpose is to thank you.

If since our last communications pertaining to it any records pertaining to the assassination of President Kennedy have surfaced I would appreciate copies.

I continue to be disturbed over the Army's destructions of not fewer than three files, the lack of any explanation of it that makes any sense at all, and the historical record this makes. It is bound to create suspicions for generations to come.
