I have sent to the Archives an additional copy of our two reports on Ferrie which I mentioned in our letter to you dated April 16, 1970.

In response to your letter of May 8, 1970, the Secret Service has no additional information concerning the exposure or handling of autopsy films. This Service is unable to explain discrepancies, if they exist, in the number of photographs taken or exposures made. We have no record on the processing of the film or any explanation why some of the film contains no image, nor do we know who might have such information.
