DETAILS

SYNOPSIS

Passport applications of Billy Lord and George B. and Mrs. Beauford Church were obtained from the Department of State, reproduced, surrendered to Inspector Kelley, and the original applications were returned to the Passport Office, Department of State.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference: Memorandum from Chief, dated 1/22/64 requesting review of passport applications of Billy Lord, passport number 1607221 and Mr. George B. and Mrs. Beauford Church, passport number 1605283.

Telephone contact was made at Washington on 1/24/64 with Mrs. Verde Crenshaw, Liaison Office, Passport Division, Department of State, and she was requested to make the passport applications of the previously mentioned individuals available. Later the same date she advised the passport applications were available and that I could borrow them for the purpose of having reproductions made.

Subsequently, on 1/24/64, I obtained the passport applications of Mr. Lord and Mr. and Mrs. Church. They were carried to the PRS where three copies were reproduced on the Xerox machine and two copies were made of the photographs of these individuals.

Two Xerox reproductions of the applications and all photographs were surrendered on the same date to Inspector Kelley, Chief's Office.
