Reports requested by the President's Commission

We have been requested by Mr. Frank Adams, a member of the President's Commission staff to secure the following information.

1. A list of all people on the Presidential plane from Fort Worth to Dallas on November 22. (The Secret Service report we furnished to the Commission had the manifest of the Presidential trip. However, what they are now requesting is a list of all the persons who actually were on the plane, if that is known).
2. Who was on the plane going back to Washington from Dallas?
3. Who was present in the cabin during the swearing-in ceremony?
4. Who was in the reception line in Dallas at the airport? (Our report indicated who was supposed to be in the reception line at the Dallas Airport, what Mr. Adams is attempting to ascertain is whether anyone knows who was absent from the reception line and/or whether anyone replaced the absentees and/or whether there were people in the reception line that were not originally scheduled to be there).

Mr. Adams realizes that the information requested in this latter category may be difficult or impossible to obtain, but he wished to make an effort to ascertain whether any reply can be made by us in this connection.

I suggest the answer be in a form of a memorandum to the Chief, indicating that the information is being forwarded at the request of Mr. Adams. The reply to the Chief should be marked for the attention of Inspector Kelley.
