Mr. and Mrs. DeMohrenschildt furnished additional information relating to Lee Oswald during an interview at this Embassy on December 19, 1963. Details of this interview are enclosed. The DeMohrenschildts again expressed their readiness to cooperate in any further way that might be desired in this matter.

As previously reported by telegram, the DeMohrenschildts had left Port-au-Prince for the provincial city of Cayes prior to receipt of the Department's telegram under reference. The Embassy finally located them in that city on December 17 and urged them to return to Port-au-Prince, which they did the following day, arriving in Port-au-Prince late on the night of December 18.

Information re Oswald's stay in Haiti to
be furnished to the Director of the FBI, by
Special Agent in Charge, NEW ORLEANS, on the above date.

1. Visit of Stan in Haiti

Mr. DeMohrenschildt stated that he had been in Haiti a couple of years ago (1961) but that his present stay began in March 1963. He was in Port-au-Prince for a number of a contract on March 13, having arrived a few days earlier and returning to the U.S. a few days later. He had spent approximately one week in Haiti at this time. He returned to Dallas then where Mrs. DeMohrenschildt had remained. He was scheduled to leave on April 19, driving to New York and Philadelphia (Mr. Bell was involved in a law suit in the latter city). They drove back to Dallas at the end of May for "two days" to pack their things and make final arrangements for going to Haiti. They exhibited an airline ticket date-stamped May 29, 1963 by the Dallas office of Pan American Airlines. They drove from Dallas to Miami at the end of May and shipped their car to Haiti from that point. They did not use their U.S. passport on these 1963 trips to Haiti, but state they entered with a tourist card. They showed Mr. Warner their joint U.S. passport which carries no stamps dated later than 1961. They exhibited a Haitian residence permit showing their date of entry into Haiti as June 2, 1963. They state they have not returned to the United States since that date.

The DeMohrenschildts state that they did not see the Oswalds at their end of May visit to Dallas.

2. Oswald's Resumé

Mr. DeMohrenschildt states he returned the resumé to Oswald. He "glanced through it, not very carefully, and gave it back to him." He does not remember precisely how long he kept the resumé but thinks it was a matter of days. In any case, he states that he returned it to Oswald the next time he saw him.

3. Oswald's Address When Gun Seen

Mrs. DeMohrenschildt's memory was not entirely clear on this point. At first she thought the Oswalds were living on Elsbeth Street in Oakleaf (a suburb of Dallas) when she saw the gun. Mr. DeMohrenschildt was not positive that it was at this location.

in any charitable work. He commented that "all the people in Dallas do know the Gosses know them purely from the point of view of helping them;" there was sympathy for Mrs. Oswald in particular because she was Russian and in a strange land and could not speak English.

Other Sources: Samuel Heller, an investment banker in Dallas. Oswald went to Heller for a job but was turned down because he had no speciality. Heller has investment interests in many enterprises all over the country employing thousands of people.

Then Heller and his wife (who is "Russian"). Mrs. Heller is an upholstering draughtsman. He works in Sangers Department Store in Dallas "as head of stock or something like that." They have no children. They took care of Marina Oswald and her baby for a while when Mrs. Oswald first was separated from her husband. (The Gosses had moved Mrs. Oswald on that occasion, from the Elsbeth Street address to the Hellers.)

DEMOSCHILDT (DM) ARRIVED PORT-AU-PRINCE LATE LAST NIGHT AND WERE INTERVIEWED THIS MORNING. THEY SUPPLIED FOLLOWING IN RESPONSE NUMBER PARAGRAPHS DEPTEL.

(1) MR. DM ARRIVED HAITI SHORTLY PRIOR MARCH 13, SIGNED CONTRACT THAT DATE AND RETURNED DALLAS AFTER APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK IN HAITI. ENTERED HAITI WITH TOURIST CARD NOT RPT NOT PASSPORT AND DOES NOT HAVE EXACT CFN 495 19 5 195 486 (1) 13

PAGE TWO RUESPR 03A LIMITED OFFICIAL USE
DATES ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE ON MARCH VISIT. MR. AND MRS. DM STATE THEY LEFT DALLAS APRIL 19 FOR NEW YORK AND PHILADELPHIA (INVOLVED IN LAW-SUIT LATTER CITY) AND RETURNED DALLAS FOR "TWO DAYS" NEAR END MAY TO MAKE FINAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR TRIP TO HAITI. PAN AM TICKET PURCHASED DALLAS MAY 29. THEN DROVE MIAMI AND ARRIVED HAITI JUNE 2, ACCORDING HAITIAN RESIDENCE PERMIT. NEITHER HAS RETURNED U.S. SINCE JUNE 2. THEY DID NOT CONTACT OSWALD ON END MAY VISIT DALLAS.

(2) DM "GLANCED THROUGH RESUME AND RETURNED IT TO OSWALD NEXT TIME SAW HIM.

(3) MRS. DM MEMORY NOT ENTIRELY CLEAR THIS POINT. FIRST REMEMBERED IT AS ELSBETH STREET IN OAKLEAF (DALLAS SUBURB). AFTER FURTHER THOUGHT BELIEVED SAW GUN AT APARTMENT APPROXIMATELY ONE BLOCK FROM ELSBETH ADDRESS. RECALLS CLEARLY APARTMENT WAS ONE FLIGHT UP IN OLD-FASHIONED HOUSE WITH LARGE "ROSE TREE" AT SIDE OF HOUSE. LATER CONSULTED HER PERSONAL TELEPHONE LIST AND DECIDED THIS MUST HAVE BEEN 214 NEELEY STREET. DATE OF VISIT: WHEN GUN SEEN NOW ESTABLISHED BY MRS. DM AS AROUND EASTER IN APRIL 1963. MR. DM WITH HER THIS OCCASION BUT DID NOT SEE GUN.

ESTED SOLELY IN HELPING THEM AS UNFORTUNATE PEOPLE. THEY COULD THINK
OF NOTHING SIGNIFICANT TO ADD TO THEIR PREVIOUS INFORMATION ON OSWALDS.
FURNISHED NAMES TWO OTHER INDIVIDUALS WHO MIGHT HAVE ADDITIONAL
INFORMATION: (1) SAMUEL BALLEW, INVESTMENT BANKER IN DALLAS TO WHOM
OSWALD APPLIED FOR JOB. (2) THEO MELLER AND WIFE (RUSSIAN). MELLER
WORKS AT SANGERS DEPT STORE, DALLAS. THEY CARED FOR MRS. OSWALD AND
BABY FOR AWHILE WHEN LATTER SEPARATED FROM HUSBAND.
