The newspaper story originating in Fort Worth concerning an eye witness to the shooting of President Kennedy indicated that an employee of the Texas Book Depository had left his job subsequent to January 1, 1964.

You are instructed to review the present employment at the Texas Book Depository to ascertain if, since the assassination, any employees have left their position. In the event any such employee is identified, a full investigation should be made to ascertain his present whereabouts, and a check should be made for any indication of undue affluence. This facet of the investigation should be kept in mind continually during subsequent months.
