Reference is made to your O/M of February 12, 1964, with enclosures.

This will confirm my telephone conversation with Inspector Peterson on February 23, 1964, in which I informed him that Mohamed Reggab had left Berlin allegedly to return to Casablanca the first week of February, 1964.

Another sensitive agency has had a number of conversations with Reggab at Berlin on which reports have been submitted to their Washington headquarters. These included a polygraph examination of Reggab which indicated deception concerning his personal contacts with Mrs. Oswald in Moscow. The agency was requested to make the complete file on Reggab at their headquarters available to you at once. This they agreed to arrange by priority cable. I will submit a more complete report without delay.
