in November, 1963

On March 19, 1964, Inspector Thomas J. Kelley telephonically advised Special Agent Frank L. Farnsworth that it was desired that the files of the two New Orleans newspapers, The Times-Picayune and New Orleans States-Item, for the period from September 12 through September 26, 1963, be checked regarding any publicity given President Kennedy's proposed trip to Texas in November of 1963.

On this same date Special Agents Farnsworth and Vial proceeded to the Record Library of The Times-Picayune and New Orleans States-Item and checked for any publicity regarding President Kennedy's trip to Texas. All clippings in the files for the period from September 12 through September 26, and also through to October 1, 1963, were reviewed. No mention was made of the state of Texas or the President's visit to that state in any of the clippings on file in the library.

As requested by Inspector Kelley, this memorandum is being forwarded by air mail.
