SUBJECT: Assassination of Pres. Kennedy - SAIC Sorrels subpoenaed in Jack Ruby case.

This is to inform you that today I was served with a subpoena to appear before Criminal District Court No. 3, Dallas County, Texas, at 9 A.M., April 29, 1964, to testify as witness in "behalf of the defendant" in a criminal action pending in said Court, entitled and numbered on the Criminal Docket of said Court, The State of Texas vs Jack Ruby, No. E-4010-J. You will also note from enclosed newspaper article that State District Attorney Henry Wade, who prosecuted Ruby for murdering Lee Harvey Oswald, has also been subpoenaed.

Asst. U. S. Attorney Timmins will be present to protect the Government's interests and he will instruct me regarding my testimony.
