SYNOPSIS

Soundsciber tapes and reels returned to two Dallas firms.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION

Reference is made to the lending to the Secret Service on April 17 and May 15, 1964, respectively, of soundsciber tapes and reels by Radio Station KSKY and KLIF in Dallas.

Other Investigations

As directed, on June 3, 1964, I returned two soundsciber tapes and reels to Station KSKY, where Mr. Bill Simmons receipted for same, and Miss Lynn Cater, of Radio Station KLIF, receipted for the three soundsciber tapes and reels, all of which had previously been loaned this Service.
