DETAILS

SYNOPSIS:

Harry Neil Olsen and Kay Olsen now living in Long Beach, California.

DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION:

Investigation was requested by SAIC Sorrels, Dallas office, on July 21, 1964 via ID telephone call, in an attempt to locate Harry Neil Olsen and his girlfriend, Kathy "Kay" Coleman, in Long Beach, California. This information was requested by the Warren Commission.

SAIC Sorrels advised that Olsen was a former Dallas, Texas police officer who was discharged in 1964; that he apparently made an application for the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Office; that he had been bonded by the Liberty Mutual Insurance Company of Boston and that he might be employed by a collection agency in Long Beach, California. Kathy Coleman was known to have been employed by Jack Ruby as a "stripper".

ATSAIC Gopadze checked the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Personnel Section and the Los Angeles City Civil Service Records on July 21 with negative results.

SA Horn checked the records of the Long Beach Police Criminal Records as well as the records of the Vice Division with negative results on that date. At the City of Long Beach Utility Department it was learned that Harry N. and Kay Olsen have service at 315 Obispo Ave., Apartment 12, since April 2, 1964. His place of employment was listed as the Doctor's Business Bureau, 1006 Heartwell Building, 19 Pine Street, Long Beach, California.

Investigation at Olsen's address revealed that his name is listed on the mailbox for apartment 12.

DISPOSITION:

This information was related to SAIC Sorrels on that date. Investigation concluded.
