On September 17, 1964, at the Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy, I declassified the following documents at the request of Sam Stern of the Commission staff.

1. A memorandum from SAIC Bouck to Chief dated December 3, 1963, subject - PRS Activities in Relation to the Texas Trip and the Assassination of President Kennedy.
2. Office memorandum from SAIC Bouck to Chief dated December 3, 1963, subject - Procedure for Handling Protective Research Information and Subjects.
3. Office memorandum from SA Lawson to Chief dated November 19, 1963, subject - The Preliminary Survey Report of the Visit of the President to Dallas, Texas, etc., the attachments on this memorandum were also declassified. Also the final survey report dated November 30, 1963, and the attachments thereto. The latter two documents were taken from the confidential Secret Service report that we submitted to the Commission. The statement of SA Lawson which was exhibit no. 9 in our report was also declassified. Also the statement dated November 23, 1963, also part of exhibit no. 9 and our report was declassified, as was SA Lawson's statement on November 22, 1963. Memorandum of our plan and a letter to Mr. Gordon was also declassified. This was done after consultation with Lamont, of the Secretary's office, who discussed the matter with Mr. Betts of Budget in the absence of Mr. Belin.
