SYNOPSIS

Elsie Killinger interviewed by telephone and has no knowledge of Boris Kara-patnitsky.

(A) INTRODUCTION:

Reference is made to memorandum report dated August 4, 1964, and to memorandum report of Special Agent Wong dated August 6, 1964, in which information regarding Boris Kara-patnitsky was developed and forwarded to Headquarters.
