Appearance Before the President's Commission

The President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy will take your testimony on Thursday, April 23, 1964, concerning the advance preparations for the trip to Dallas. The general subject matter of the Commission's inquiry will be the advance preparations for the Dallas trip, including the activities of the Protective Research Section, and the events actually observed by you and Special Agent Lawson in Dallas on November 22, and thereafter.

The Commission has been advised that it may be inconvenient because of a family situation for you to leave Dallas during that week. Should this continue to be the case, the Commission has agreed to reschedule your testimony for a convenient day during the week beginning April 27. Do not hesitate to contact Inspector Kelley and request him to reschedule your testimony if the April 23 date will cause you concern because of your family situation.

The General Counsel of the Treasury Department wishes to discuss with you the proposed testimony before your appearance at the Commission. If you will be available for the April 23 date, you should report to my office during the morning of April 22. It is suggested that you call Inspector Kelley in the afternoon of April 21 and advise him whether you will be in Washington April 22 for the conference with the General Counsel.
