## Assassination Unit

Formation of a new na-tional Committee to Investigate Assassinatiors was announced. It will have its headquarters in Washington. the executive director of the Committee is Bernard Fenşterwald, former counsel to a Senate Judiciary subcommittee that investigated

wiretapping and electronic surveillance.

Fensterwald said "the United States is fast becoming a banana republic" and "assassinations are becoming a regular part of our political process."

He said the new committee "ultimately hopes to force the Federal Government into the thorough and honest inquiry which it has avoided since Nov. 22, 1953."

Among the directors of the committee are Jim Garrison, the New Orleans district attorney who has been conducting an investigation said "the Fensterwald
