SUBJECT: Washington, D.C. Examiner Article on "New JFK Probe"

Inquiries on Capitol Hill revealed that it is rumored that a probe concerning the assassination of President Kennedy will be undertaken by several members of the Sub-Committee on Administrative Practices and Procedures, which is located in the New Senate Office Building, Room 5617. The probe will be conducted by persons who are leaving the Committee and is in no way officially connected with any Senate Committee and Sub-Committee. The Chief Counsel of this Sub-Committee is Bernard Fensterwald, Jr., who has been mentioned in several newspaper and magazine articles.

A request was made to the Library of Congress to obtain the articles in which Mr. Fensterwald is mentioned, since it was rumored that he may be directing the assassination probe. These articles are attached to this report.
