SUBJECT: Igor Vaganov aka Turk

Reference is made to previous memorandum reports in this case, the latest being that of SA Michael A. Kelly, Philadelphia, dated January 2, 1964.

Attached are photostatic copies of articles which appeared in the January 1967 issue of the PHILADELPHIA MAGAZINE and the August 1967 issue of ESQUIRE MAGAZINE relating to the subject of this memorandum.

These articles were received by ASAIC Charles E. Taylor, of this office, from SA Leonardos Karlos, Inspection Service, Internal Revenue Service, Philadelphia, Pa. Karlos advised ASAIC Taylor that a reliable informant advised Karlos that he felt the Secret Service was not aware of the complete background of the subject. The informant advised that the individual referred to in the PHILADELPHIA MAGAZINE article as "Brown" is actually Vaganov. This informant also advised that the last known address of Vaganov was 49 Brandon Road, Upper Darby, Pa.; that a complete record of Vaganov can be obtained from Mr. Fred R. Dickson, Administrator, Interstate Compact, Adult Authority, State Office Building #1, Sacramento, California, and that the subject visited the states of North Carolina and California during June and July 1967.

On October 7, 1968, SA Donald C. Brett, of this office, advised ASAIC Louis Sims, Intelligence Division, of this information; ASAIC Sims requested copies of these articles and indicated that no further investigation is requested at this time.
