Man Detained at Reagan Stop

BALTIMORE, Md. (AP)—Police detained an unidentified man in a squad car during California Gov. Ronald Reagan's three-hour stopover at Friendship International Airport Sunday.

The man, who police say allegedly threatened the late President John F. Kennedy some years ago, was picked up in the crowd that awaited the governor's airplane.

Police said he was detained in

a squad car parked in nearby woods and released after Reagan left for Cincinnati. Federal agents followed the man here from Texas and notified local police of his whereabouts, authorities reported.

Reagan met with Republican delegates from several states and held a news conference at the airport.
