WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate has voted to provide Mrs. John F. Kennedy with Secret Service protection until her death or she remarries.

The action, subject to House approval, would extend the same protection to her children until they reach the age of 16.

Existing law calls for Secret Service protection for the widow

Existing law calls for Secret Service protection for the widow of a president for four years after he dies in office. The four years expired in Mrs. Kennedy's case November 1967. Protection since then has been on a year to year basis.
